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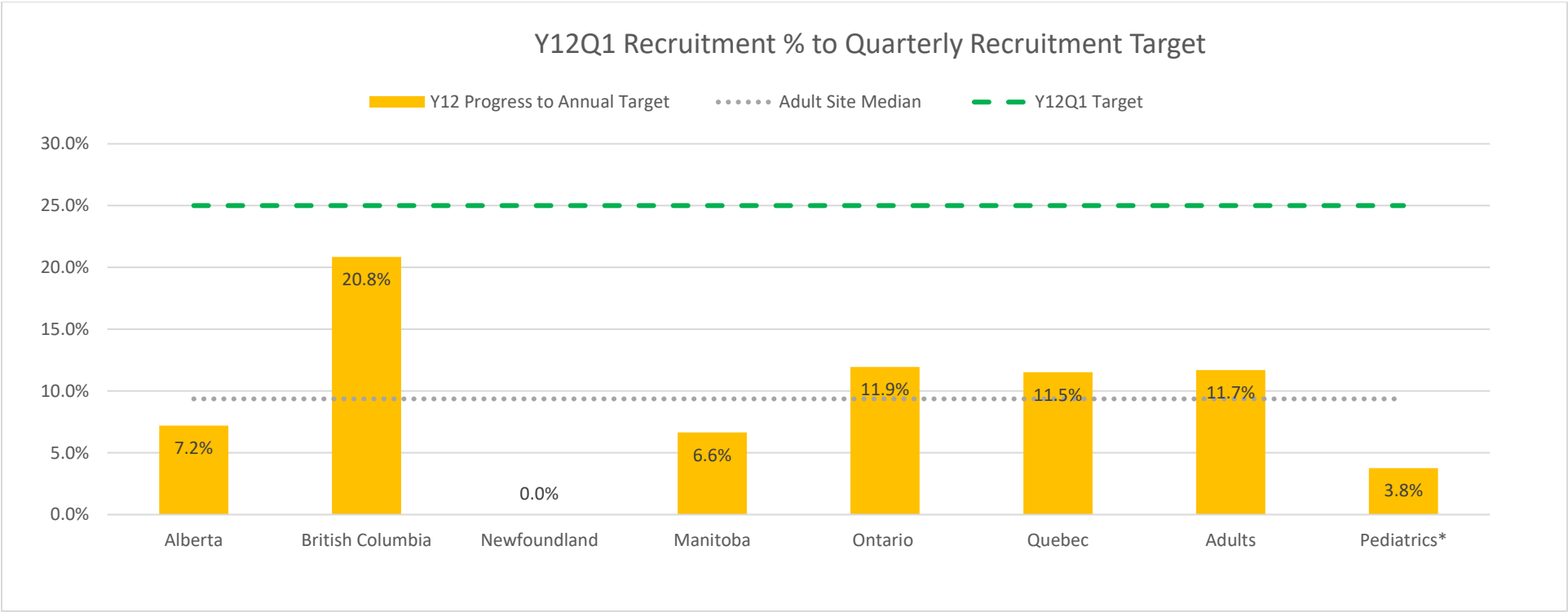
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Section A: Patient Access and Recruitment to the 3CTN Portfolio Trials

Patient Recruitment at All Network Sites

Objective: To improve patient access to academic clinical trials and improve patient recruitment by greater than 100% within five years.



Notes:

- 505 patients were recruited (482 to Adult and 23 to Pediatric cancer centres) to Portfolio trials in Quarter 1.
- Overall, ~18.4% of Adult Sites (7 out of 38) are on track to meet or exceed their Y12 target of 95% above pre-3CTN baseline.
- *Pediatric progress to pre-3CTN baseline recruitment is shown.

Patient Access: Adolescent and Young Adult (AYA) and Remote Access Recruitment

Objective: To improve trial access and overcome barriers to trial participation for under-represented populations.

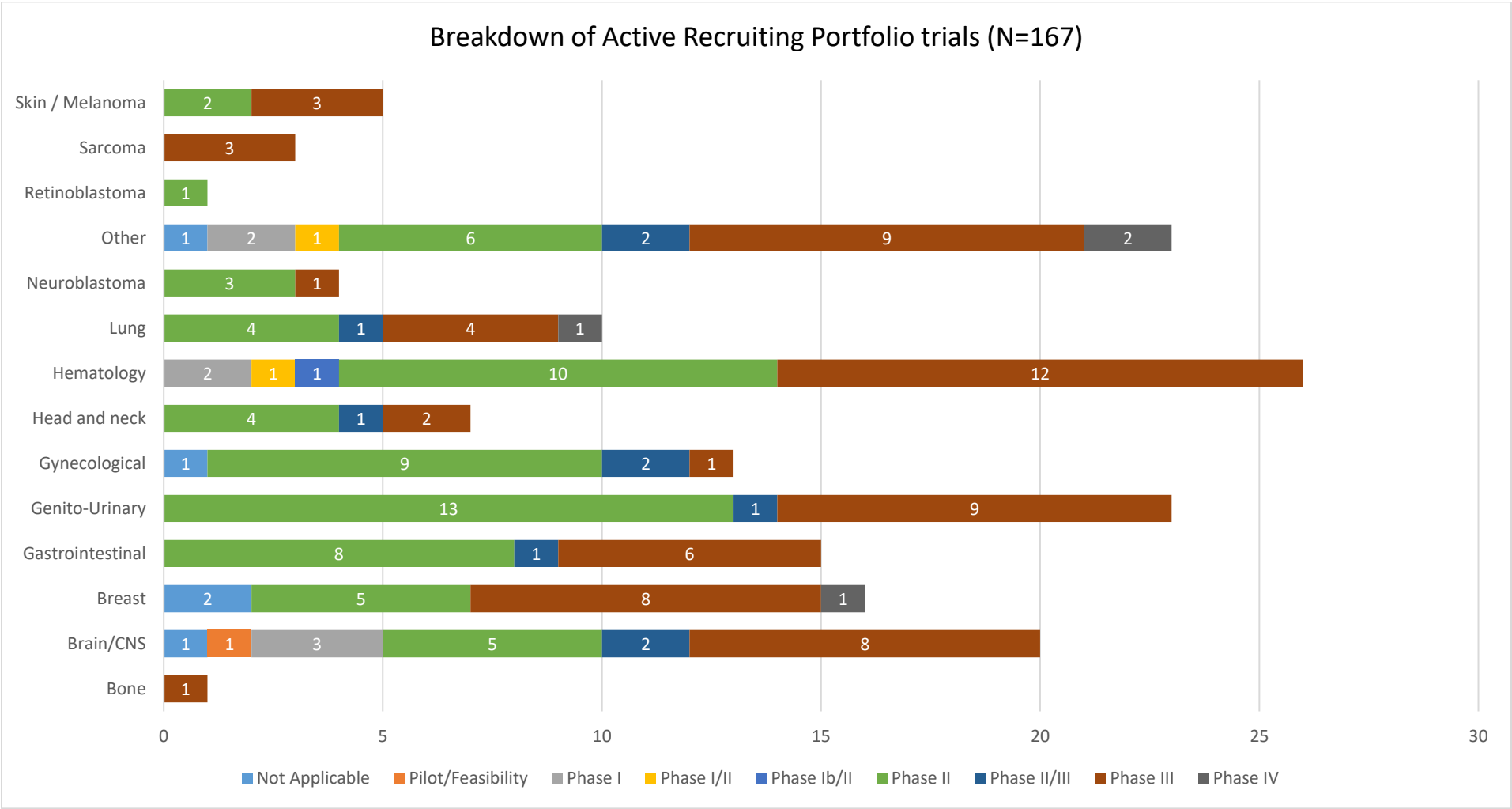
