#### **EDI Demonstration Projects: Request for Applications**

### Accelerating implementation of best practices for advancing equity across the Canadian clinical trials ecosystem

• FY 24/25 Funding envelope: \$250K received from



- To build on early CRAFT successes and the recently launched EDI Framework to support projects for:
  - Implementation of EDI best practices for cancer clinical trials conduct
  - CRAFT trial cluster setup
- Budget: up to \$20,000 available per project
- Funding period: up to 5 months (November 2024 March 2025)



#### **Equity-Deserving Groups**

#### Improve pan-Canadian trial access and increased accrual among,

- Indigenous Peoples (First Nations, Inuit, and Métis)
- Racial and ethnic minority groups
- Older Adults
- Adolescents and Young adults (AYA)
- Immigrants/newcomers
- Remote and rural individuals
- Persons with disabilities
- Members of sexual and gender diverse communities



## Who is eligible to apply?

#### Open to 3CTN member cancer centres

#### Collaboration is encouraged!

- patient groups, advocacy groups/orgs.
- other 3CTN member centres, as may be required, for added feasibility & impact

#### **Intended Benefits**

- Seed funding to help promote sites' development of impactful EDI initiatives
- Accelerate progress of defined EDI, DCT M&Ds

- How? leverage existing relationships, establishing connections with appropriate representatives
